Minor hockey is about development, teamwork, and enjoyment of the game—for players, coaches, officials, and families alike. Creating a safe, respectful, and positive arena environment is a shared responsibility.

To ensure the best possible experience for everyone involved, we remind all **coaches, team staff, parents, and fans** that the following Code of Conduct applies at all games, practices, and events.

### Our Commitment

We are committed to:

- Sportsmanship and fair play
  - Respect for players, officials, volunteers, and opponents
  - A positive environment where young athletes can learn and grow
- 

### Coaches and Team Staff Are Expected To

- Lead by example with professionalism and respect
  - Teach the rules and spirit of the game
  - Communicate positively with players and officials
  - Never use abusive language or gestures
  - Place player development, safety, and enjoyment above winning
- 

### Parents & Guardians Are Expected To

- Support all players, not just your own child
- Encourage effort, improvement, and teamwork
- Allow coaches to coach and officials to officiate
- Address concerns respectfully and at appropriate times
- Refrain from coaching from the stands

## Fans & Spectators Are Expected To

- Cheer positively and respectfully
  - Never criticize or verbally abuse players, coaches, or officials
  - Avoid profanity, taunting, or discriminatory language
  - Remember that officials are human and learning, just like players
  - Create an atmosphere where children feel safe and supported

## Zero Tolerance

Any form of:

- Harassment or intimidation
- Verbal or physical abuse
- Discriminatory or threatening behavior

may result in **removal from the arena**, disciplinary action, or further consequences as deemed appropriate by Mooretown Minor Hockey Association Disciplinary Committee.
