Hotel Rules & Policy of Respect and Good Behaviour

Purpose:

To ensure a safe, respectful, and positive experience for all players, parents, team officials, hotel staff, and other guests during team travel events.

1. General Expectations

- All players, parents, coaches, and team personnel represent the team, association, and community at all times.
 - Respectful and responsible behaviour is expected both in and out of the hotel.
 - Disruptive behaviour will not be tolerated and may result in disciplinary action.
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2. Hotel Conduct

- **Noise Levels:** Keep noise to a minimum, especially in hallways and common areas. Observe hotel quiet hours (usually 10:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m.).
 - **Room Behaviour:** No running, roughhousing, or playing mini-sticks in hotel rooms or hallways.
 - **Property Respect:** Do not damage or misuse hotel property. Any damages may be charged to the responsible individual or team.
 - **Room Visits:** No visiting other rooms after curfew hours. Respect personal space and privacy.
 - **Elevators & Stairs:** Use elevators responsibly. Do not overcrowd, jump, or press multiple buttons unnecessarily.
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3. Curfew & Supervision

- **Curfew Time:** All players must be in their rooms by the designated curfew set by team officials.
 - **Supervision:** Coaches and/or designated adults will ensure curfews and behaviour standards are followed.
 - **Buddy System:** Players are encouraged to stay in pairs or groups when moving through the hotel or attending events.
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4. Alcohol, Drugs, and Smoking

- **Zero Tolerance:** Underage drinking, drug use, or possession of tobacco, nicotine products or vaping products is strictly prohibited.
 - **Adults:** Parents and adults must consume alcohol responsibly and in designated areas only. Any alcohol beverage is to be consumed responsibly in the presence of players.
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5. Respect for Hotel Staff and Other Guests

- Follow all hotel rules and requests from hotel staff.
 - Be courteous and respectful to other guests.
 - Do not loiter in hotel lobbies, hallways, or near guest rooms.
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6. Meals and Common Areas

- Clean up after yourself in breakfast areas, lounges, and other common spaces.
 - Respect shared spaces like the pool, gym, or meeting rooms.
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7. Disciplinary Action

Failure to comply with these rules may result in:

- Removal from team activities
 - Immediate return home at the family's expense
 - Suspension or removal from the team for serious or repeated offenses
 - Reporting of incidents to the hockey association or governing body
