ADVANCED PLAYER GUIDELINE

What is an Advanced Player?

- An Advanced Player is any player that exceeds the ability, skill, and athleticism of other players in that division.
- An Advanced player has the necessary attributes to successfully play a higher- level team as determined by a committee

What is the Criteria?

- Assessment occurs during September Tryouts
- Parent of player must notify coach of the higher-level team the intent to tryout. The coach will notify the VP Hockey Operations and provide feedback on this player if possible.
- If approved, the player pays for higher division tryout fee and their original division Tryout fee
- Player is guaranteed two tryouts at both levels
- If the player is released by the B team, they are eligible to tryout for the AE team in the higher division or attend their regular Division B team Tryout.
- Player will be evaluated by a Committee selected by the VP Hockey Operations
- If successful, player will be moved to higher level team
- If unsuccessful, the VP Hockey Operations will explain the committee’s decision
